<b>TRADES:</b>	<b>R3.2 Trades</b> are permitted after positions have been drawn during call back and at least one-half hour (1/2hr) prior to stock draws for performances or slack in accordance with the following: <b>a.</b> Position trades shall be made with central entry during call back only or with arena secretaries on days of a rodeo only. <b>b.</b> All parties desiring trades must contact central entry during call back or arena secretaries on days of a rodeo to initiate and verify trades. <b>c.</b> Verification of trades by all involved parties with central entry or arena secretaries must be by telephone, cell phone, or in writing signed by all involved parties.
<b>GROUND RULES:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No stock in any event (except re-rides or re-runs) may be taken before the 1<sup>st</sup> section of that event, or held beyond the section it is drawn</li> <li>• All contestants are welcome to stall their horses in the large yellow barn and then must be removed before 9:00 am the following morning.</li> <li>• The arena closes ½ hour before every performance.</li> <li>• Both the inside and surrounding area of the race track is a golf course. Anyone parking, riding, and/or driving beyond the roped area will be ticketed.</li> <li>• No stock in any event except for re-rides or re-runs may be taken before the first section of that event or held beyond the section in which it was drawn.</li> <li>• All vehicles must be out of the infield after the end of each show. Violators will be ticketed.</li> </ul>
