All parties desiring trades must contact central entry during call back or arena secretaries on days of a rodeo to initiate and verify trades.</i> <i>c. Verification of trades by all involved parties with central entry or arena secretaries must be by telephone, cell phone, or in writing signed by all involved parties.</i>
